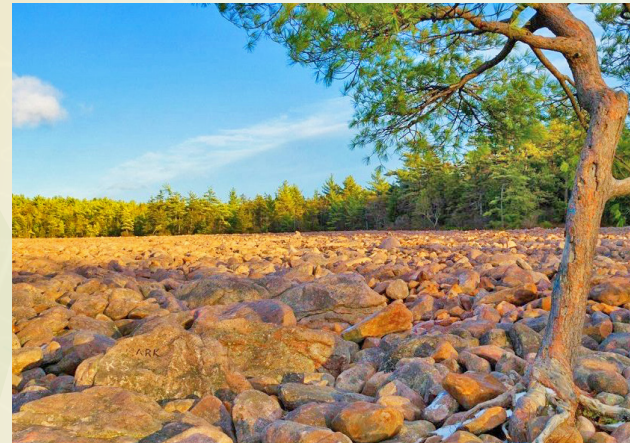

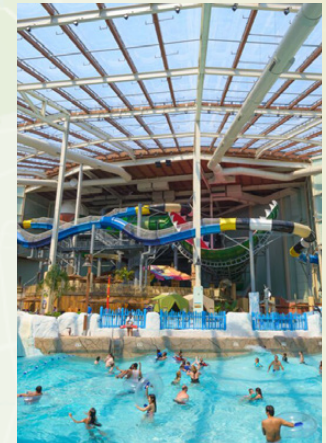
The Pocono Mountains

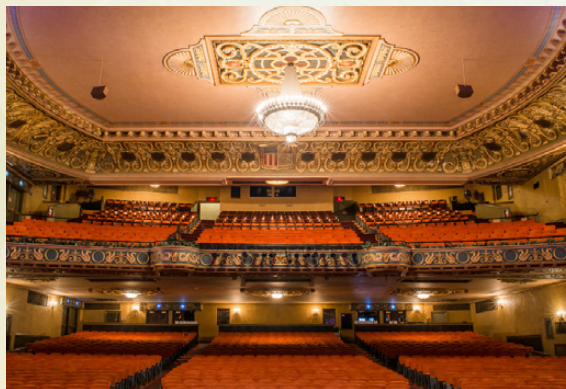
